Farm Stock Pull Rules

CLASSES:

10,500 lbs. NA 8MPH
10,500 lbs. Turbo 8MPH
12,400 lbs. Turbo 8 MPH
12,000 lbs. Turbo 15 MPH

100 lbs. overweight allowed for each class.

Drivers' meeting 15 minutes prior to start time.

Tractors must be weighed and registered prior to the drivers' meeting.

Minimum age 16 years old with valid driver's license required to pull.

Safety equipment HIGHLY recommended.

\$30 per hook.

RULES:

Judge's discretion on ALL rules whether expressly stated here or not.

- 1. Maximum engine RPMs 2,800.
- 2. Speed limit enforced.
 - a. Speed violations:
 - i. Prior to 75 ft. Result in a warning via horn on sled.
 - ii. After 75 ft. Result in disqualification.
- 3. MAXIMUM hitch height 20 inches. Must be stationary in all directions.
- 4. Hitch must be a least 18 inches from the center of the rear axle.
 - a. Operator of tractor must provide twisted clevis or bolt on plow loop with a minimum opening size of 3 inches.
- 5. Maximum Tire size 20.8 x 38 or 18.4 x 42.
 - a. No cut or altered tires.
 - b. No Duals.
- 6. Wheel weights and suitcase weights are allowed.
 - a. Weights must be securely fastened to tractor.
 - b. Weights or parts of the tractor that fall off during pull will result in disqualification.
- 7. Weights may extend out past the rear axle of the tractor but not further than the maximum radius of the rear tire.
- 8. Front weights allowed.
 - a. Weights and/or weight bracket not to exceed 24 inches past factory frame.
- 9. All drivers must remain seated with at least one hand on the steering wheel at all times while pulling.
- 10. All tractors operated in an unsafe manner on or off the track will result in disqualification.

- 11. No injectables.
- 12. OEM style intercoolers allowed
 - a. Aftermarket style intercoolers not permitted.
- 13. Tractors must be stock appearing.
