GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

Exhibitors please take notice and observe carefully.

1. Exhibitors may make unlimited entries in most class numbers, but may place with only two entries per class number. Some classes do have limited numbers of entries.
2. **ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED UNLESS ACCOMPANIED BY SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER, RELEASE FORM SIGNATURES, AND PAYMENT OF EXHIBITOR'S PERMIT.**
3. ****Please Note** ENTRY FORMS MUST BE IN THE FAIR OFFICE BY 6:00 PM, Sat., July 1, 2017 or POSTMARKED BY July 1, 2017. Walk-in entries will be accepted in the fair office from June 19 thru June 23 (9 am – 3 pm), June 26 (9am – 3pm) and June 27 thru June 29 (9 am - 6 pm).**
4. **ENTRY FORMS** - Exhibitor's name must match social security number given. **Entry will be determined by class number given on entry form.** Entry forms may be photocopied, if needed.
5. Article identification tags must be filled in with COMPLETE information and attached to entry in an inconspicuous place. Name to be taped to bottom of containers. Containers must be clean and plants well groomed. Please identify plants.
6. All entries in plant division must have been grown and owned by exhibitor for at least sixty days.
7. **Flowers or greenery from a florist are not allowed.**
8. **No artificial flowers or foliage may be used.**
9. **No entry can be exhibited more than once, if it has been exhibited in previous years and won.**
10. **Floriculture entries may be placed in the department area on Tuesday, July 11, 2017, between 4:00 – 6:00 p.m. or on Wednesday, July 12, 2017, between 7:00 – 10:00 a.m. (We encourage exhibitors to bring entries Wednesday morning so flowers and plants are fresh for judging).**
11. Every exhibit entered for competition shall be under the control of the Superintendents and staged at their and the committee's direction. The committee reserves the right to stage all categories and place all entries in correct class number.
12. Exhibitors may be present during judging. Critique and comments will be given after judging is completed if judge(s) wish to comment. Judge(s) may desire to give written comments. Judging will take place on Wednesday, July 12, 2017 at 11:00 a.m.
13. Exhibits will be maintained during the fair, but the Fair Association and committee in no way assumes responsibility for them.
14. There will be no storage space available for boxes etc.
15. No refunds to non-winners.
16. **Exhibits must be removed on Sunday evening, July 16 at 5 pm.** Leaving before release time will mean forfeiture of premium checks.

Potted plants will be judged on Condition, Uniformity, Stem and Foliage, Color and Size, Quality/Quantity of flowers if any.
