GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

Exhibitors please take notice and observe carefully.

Exhibitors may make as many entries in each class number as they wish but can only place with two entries per class number.

ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED UNLESS RELEASE FORM IS SIGNED AND PAYMENT OF EXHIBITOR'S PERMIT IS RECEIVED.

****PLEASE NOTE** ENTRY FORMS MUST BE IN THE FAIR OFFICE BY July 1, 2019 or POSTMARKED BY July 1, 2019 if mailed.**

Articles to be exhibited must be brought to the Commercial Building from 2:00 pm to 6:00 pm on Tuesday, July 9, 2019.

ENTRY FORMS - Entry will be determined by class number given. Entry forms may be photocopied, if needed.

All articles in the class must be correctly named and labeled and must have been grown or produced by the exhibitor. Only one plate of each variety of fruit will be permitted to compete for the same premium.

Fruit competing for the same premium must be arranged together and separate samples must be furnished for each entry.

No refunds to non-winners.

Release time will be 5:00 pm Sunday, July 14, 2019. All exhibits are to be removed then, unless otherwise authorized.
