## SHOW RULES AND REGULATIONS

Exhibitors, please take notice and observe carefully.

**ALL POULTRY MUST BE ON THE FAIRGROUNDS BY 7:00 PM ON THURSDAY, JULY 18, 2024.**

**ALL POULTRY WILL BE RELEASED AT 7:00 PM ON SUNDAY, JULY 21, 2024.**

**\*\*\*\*\* PLEASE NOTE – ALL ENTRIES MUST BE MADE IN PERSON OR BY MAIL (POSTMARKED) NO LATER THAN JULY 1, 2024. ADDRESS ENTRIES TO MARSHALL-PUTNAM FAIR, P.O. BOX 114, HENRY, ILLINOIS 61537. WALK-IN ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED IN THE FAIR OFFICE MONDAY – THURSDAY FROM JUNE 15 - JULY 1, 2024. ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED UNLESS ACCOMPANIED BY A COMPLETED ENTRY FORM, PROPER RELEASE FORM SIGNATURES, AND PAYMENT OF THE EXHIBITOR'S PERMIT.**

It is the exhibitor's responsibility to check your entry receipts to make sure you are entered in the correct classes in our computer. If you enter through the mail, your receipt is available in the fair office and must be checked by 9 pm on Thursday, July 18<sup>th</sup>. Changes will not be made during the Poultry Show.

No money covering entry fees and exhibitor's permit will be refunded.

No paper bedding may be used.

An exhibitor can win only two premiums per class number.

No refund to non-winners.

Exhibitor is to bring own feed and feed pans.

All poultry must meet health requirements set forth by the Illinois Department of Agriculture - Bureau of Animal Health. Please see Health Requirements governing exhibits in this department. All proper papers must be shown to the superintendent prior to unloading of poultry. Those not having papers will not be allowed to show and all entry fees will be forfeited. This is a state regulation and all those in show must comply.

Anyone needing blood-testing should contact the Fair Office for a list of private poultry testers authorized by the Illinois Department of Agriculture.

Premium checks MUST be picked up at the Fair Office at 7 pm on Sunday, NO CHECKS WILL BE MAILED.

The American Standard of Perfection will be the guide for judging poultry.

### **ENTRY FORMS –**

Entry must be made in the name of the owner.

Entries will be determined by class number given.

Entry forms may be photocopied if needed.

**No entry fee needs to be paid for Champion classes.**
